### DAY 1 – Arrive in Whitehorse, YT + Northern Lights Viewing.

Arrive in Whitehorse this afternoon. Transfer to your hotel in downtown Whitehorse is included in your tour package. Whitehorse, located close to the famous Yukon River, is a small city, easy to explore on foot or by vehicle. Later in the evening, your tour will set out for the Aurora Centre where you will seek the sight of Northern Lights.

Your tour includes a visit to the SS Klondike National Historic Site, among the last of the great paddle-wheelers that plied the Yukon River system until the 1950's. Also included in your tour is a visit to the Old Log Church; the oldest building in Whitehorse, the unique Log Cabin Skyscraper; a three-story tower made completely out of logs. Later, stroll down the Main Street with its galleries and cafés.

From here, the tour will travel a short distance to Takhini Hot Springs where you can indulge yourself in the natural hot springs and relax in a breathtaking winter mountain setting.
