Day 9 – Travel to Quebec + Tour of Quebec City and visit to Montmorency Falls.

The Charlevoix landscape was defined millions of years ago by a massive meteorite that crashed down in the area forming hills and creating a deep crater of nearly 60 kilometres diameter. If you are in the geology field by profession and /or by passion, this will for sure fascinate you! Alternatively, go on a Whale Watching Cruise in Tadoussac.

Day 13 – Transfer from La Malbaie to Quebec City Airport.

This morning, post breakfast and checkout. Your driver will transfer you to the Airport at Quebec City.
