Restrictions related to this tour/soft adventure activity:

Please note the following terms & conditions and restrictions apply to participants undertaking this tour:

- Medical/Physical, Mobility Issues: This tour/soft adventure is not recommended for persons with heart
 or back condition, mobility issues, pregnant women, etc. Please let us know of any physical/health
 condition that you may have so we can confirm your acceptance on this tour/soft adventure.
- **Experience:** No prior experience is required as such. You will be given proper briefing before start of this tour.
- Dress Code, Helmets, etc.: There are strict dress code guidelines that must be followed for safety purposes. These specific requirements will be communicated to you at the time your tour is confirmed.
- Waiver: In most cases, signing a Waiver is required. Your tour/soft adventure includes components that is considered as a soft adventure activity, and therefore you are required to sign a Liability Waiver issued by the operator of that tour or soft adventure activity. This requirement will be clearly indicated at the time of booking and on your tour voucher. Additionally, for all participants under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian must sign the Waiver on their behalf.

General Notes:

- a) Tipping and gratuities are not included.
- b) Aurora Borealis are spectacular to experience but as a natural phenomenon, its appearance cannot be guaranteed.
- c) All wildlife should be considered unpredictable and potentially dangerous. If a large predator is visible but not close alter your route and move away from the area.
- d) Pricing can fluctuate with exchange rates and confirmation is subject to availability.
- e) Please ensure to prepare for winter conditions and pack your clothes appropriately.

FAQ

- What are the amenities available at the resort? Wood burning fireplace, lighting, Power outlets, WIFI access, camping facilities are some of the amenities available at the resort.
- What are the activities available at the resort? Day time activities during winter include snowmobiling, snowshoeing, ice fishing, hiking, nature exploration.
 - Daytime activities during summer include ATVing, hiking, fishing, berry picking, nature walThere are indigenous activities that one can take part in namely smudging, culinary experience, teaching circle, storytelling, learning about nature.
 - Post dinner gather to watch the enchanting Aurora Borealis near a pit fire area to stay warm or listen to captivating stories about nature under the starlit sky.
- Why do we recommend 3 days stay? To watch the Aurora Borealis the colder the better. We need clear skies with no cloud cover, therefore we go out for 3 nights, so we have the best chance to see the Aurora Borealis as only the Gods can predict the weather.



- Clothing Don't forget your winter gear/outfits. You will require a proper jacket, shoes and snow pants.
 Winter Boots, Paints, and coats are rentable at the village at a cost. Winter toques for head wear and mitts are not rented at camp.
 - **Do I require a Travel Insurance?** A 3rd party travel insurance is strongly recommended, as we cannot guarantee that there will not be any events outside of our control i.e. delays or cancellations or even medical emergency
 - Is this a private or a shared experience? This tour/soft adventure activity is a shared experience. There will be other participants on this tour/soft adventure activity.
 - Is this tour customizable? Subject to availability, we can operate this tour/soft adventure activity as a fully customized Private Tour experience, exclusive to you. Additional costs will apply. Please check with us for more details.
 - Are there fixed dates of departure for this tour? Yes. There are specific dates in the season when this tour operates.
 - Is it necessary to sign a Waiver to participate in your tours? In most cases, signing a Waiver is required. Your tour includes a component that is considered a soft adventure activity, and therefore you to obliged to sign a Liability Waiver issued by the operator of that tour or activity. This requirement will be clearly indicated on your tour voucher. Additionally, for all participants under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian must sign the Waiver on their behalf.
 - Are children allowed to participate in certain tours and soft adventure activities? Yes. Once again, such restrictions are pointed out under "Restrictions".
 - Can we expect to see wildlife on these tours? While there is always a chance to spot wildlife during our tours, and such sightings are not uncommon, we must clarify that seeing wildlife is not a guaranteed aspect of our tours. Our guides possess extensive knowledge about the animals in the park and will gladly share information about them, should you see any wildlife or have questions about the local fauna.
 - Is it safe to approach or touch wild animals based on their behavior? Absolutely not. Under no circumstances should you approach, touch, or exit your vehicle to photograph wild animals, regardless of their apparent calmness or friendliness. Interacting with wild animals poses significant risks to both humans and the animals themselves.
 - Is it mandatory to present Service Vouchers received from DMCi for availing confirmed services during our tour, including hotel accommodations and tours? Yes, it is mandatory. To avail of the services confirmed for your tour, including hotel accommodations and tours, you must present a digital or printed copy of the Service Voucher provided to you by DMCi or your travel agent at the time-of-service confirmation. Failure to present this voucher may result in denial of services. Please note that in such circumstances, no refunds, substitutions, or alternative tours or services will be provided.
 - What is the policy in case your client's flight gets cancelled or delayed, or if they are unable to travel and join the tour for other reasons? DMCi Inc., our service providers, employees, contractors & sub-contractors etc. are responsible only for services booked through us.
