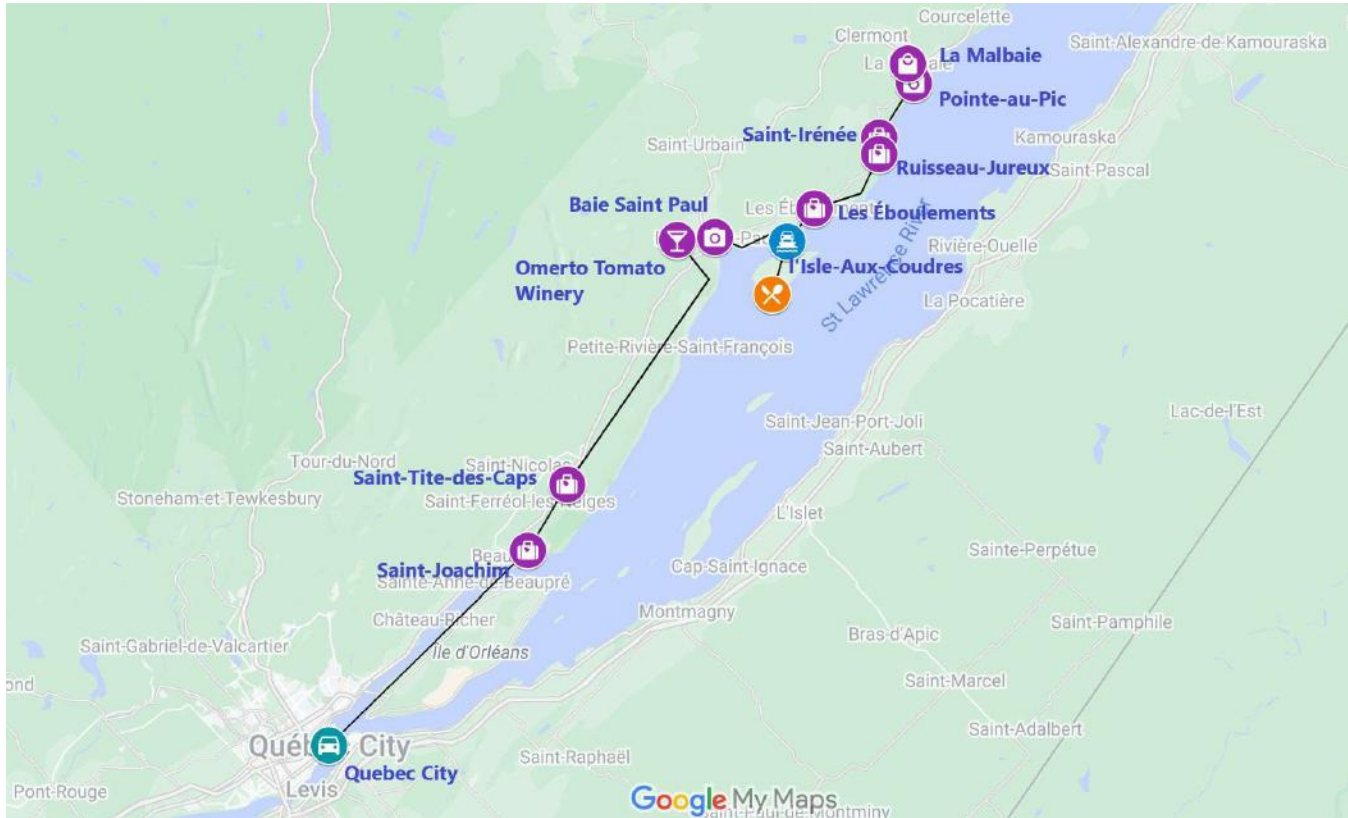

Travel along the scenic Route du Fleuve, where stunning fall foliage awaits. Next, take a peaceful ferry ride to l'Isle-aux-Coudres, where a delicious Quebecois lunch awaits. End your day with a visit to La Malbaie's Fairmont Manoir Richelieu and the Charlevoix Maritime Museum, capturing memories at every stop.

Omerto, The Tomato Wine Place, offers a unique experience of tomato winemaking. Using a traditional method, tomatoes are fermented in small batches and aged in oak barrels, resulting in a savory, gluten-free, and vegan-friendly wine. Visitors can enjoy a tour lasting 60 to 120 minutes, learning about tomato conservation and the complete winemaking process. Omerto also creates tomato-based condiments, making it a delightful destination for wine lovers and those with dietary restrictions.

Baie Saint Paul is a beautiful town by the Saint Lawrence River, surrounded by hills and forests. Visitors can enjoy its rich cultural history, explore art galleries, and visit unique shops and restaurants. The town is also home to the famous Le Massif de Charlevoix ski resort. Take a stroll through its charming streets and taste the delicious food from the region.

The Route du Fleuve offers 78 kilometers of stunning views along the St. Lawrence River, from Baie-Saint-Paul to La Malbaie. Visitors can enjoy scenic drives, taste local treats like maple syrup, cheese, and cider, and stop at farms or markets along the way. Whether you dine in Baie-Saint-Paul or wait for a meal on l'Isle-aux-Coudres, you'll experience the best of Quebec's cuisine.

Les Moulins de l'Isle-aux-Coudres offers delicious Quebecois food, with fresh bread baked on-site. After enjoying lunch, explore the island's beauty by car. When leaving, take the scenic drive through charming towns like Les Éboulements and Saint-Irénée, with the St. Lawrence River at your side.

Pointe-au-Pic is a lovely village known for its beautiful scenery and rich history. Visitors can enjoy views of the river and mountains, take peaceful walks through the charming streets, and explore cultural attractions in the area. It's a perfect spot for a relaxing day out.

La Malbaie, the final stop on your Route du Fleuve journey, is known for its natural beauty and rich history. Once a popular resort for wealthy families in the 19th and 20th centuries, some historic homes are still preserved, like the Manoir Richelieu hotel.
