

Day 1: Arrival at Halifax and Start Your Cabot Trail Journey in Halifax

Driving Distance: 33 KM | 20 Miles

Day 2: Alexander Graham Bell and Scenic Baddeck

Driving Distance: 358 KM | 222 Miles

In Baddeck, guests are welcomed to explore the Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site, a key highlight celebrating the inventor's contributions. To top off the day, an authentic lobster dinner experience offers guests a taste of Nova Scotia's maritime charm and culinary traditions.

Day 5: Coastal Drive, Meat Cove, and Whale Watching

Driving Distance: 115 KM | 72 Miles

Later, travelers can embark on a whale-watching cruise in Pleasant Bay, followed by a hike on the Skyline Trail with panoramic views of the Cabot Trail and the Gulf of St. Lawrence. The day concludes in the charming Acadian village of Cheticamp, where guests can enjoy the local culture, seafood, and stunning sunsets.
