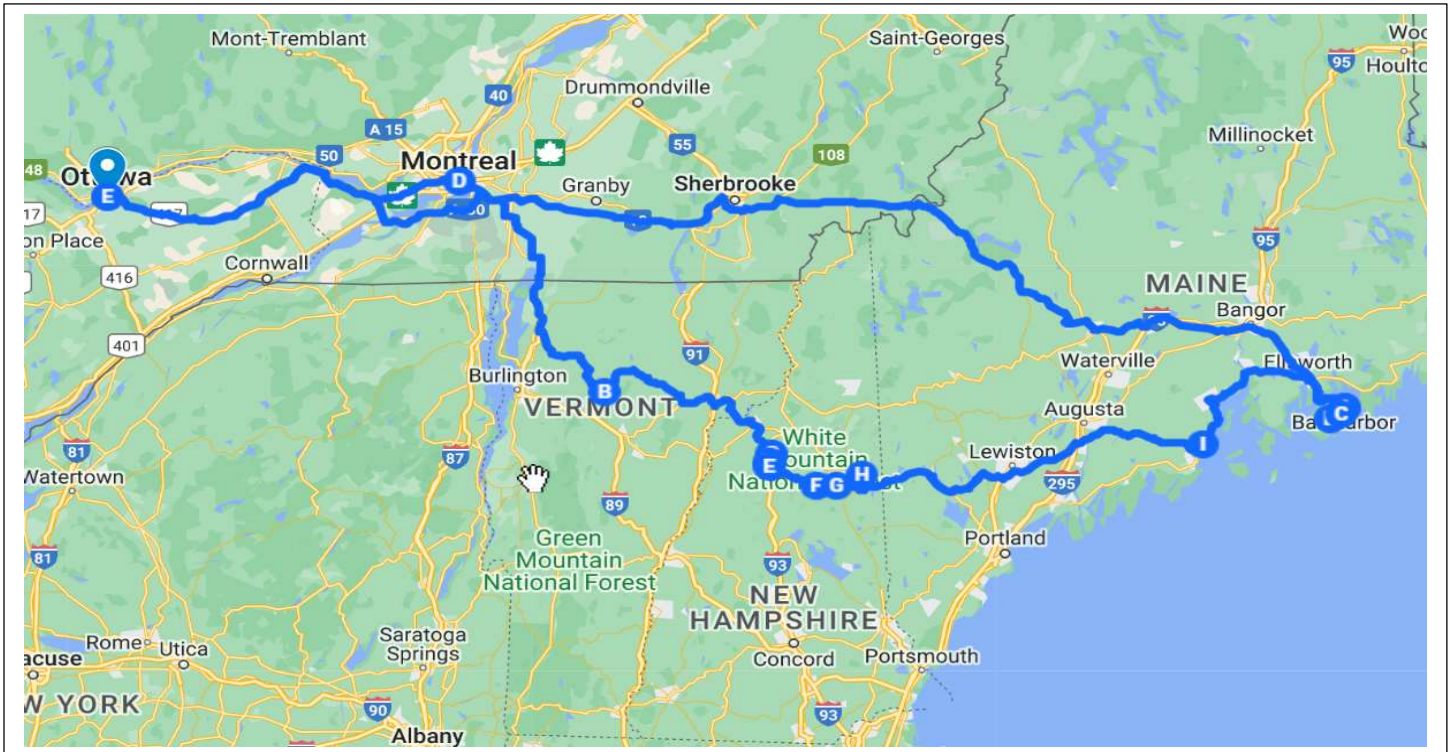

Day 1: Ottawa to Stowe, VT. Discover Stowe's Fall Foliage and Local Flavors

Driving Distance: 364 KM

Highlights of the Day:

- Wander the charming streets of Stowe, VT.
- Visit Ben & Jerry's Factory, tour the Flavor Graveyard.
- Enjoy scenic views of Mount Mansfield on Route 108.
- Savor a delicious farm-to-table dinner experience.

Your day begins with a scenic drive from Ottawa, arriving in the charming village of Stowe, Vermont by late morning. Start your adventure with a refreshing maple latte from Black Cap Coffee and a leisurely stroll through Stowe's quaint streets, visiting local shops like The Country Store on Main and Bear Pond Books. Snap fun photos by the Stowe mural at Laughing Moon Chocolates. After a delicious lunch at The Bench or Harrison's Restaurant & Bar, embark on a delightful Ben & Jerry's Factory tour where you can explore the famous Flavor Graveyard and enjoy a sweet ice cream treat. Next, drive along the scenic Route 108, soaking in the magnificent views of Mount Mansfield and the vibrant fall foliage.

Your day continues with a visit to the Trapp Family Lodge, the historic Gold Brook Covered Bridge, and a cider tasting at Cold Hollow Cider Mill. End your evening with a delightful farm-to-table dinner at Hen of the Wood, followed by a peaceful night in cozy Stowe accommodations. If you're up for it, enjoy stargazing or take a serene evening walk to close the day on a perfect note.

Day 2: Stowe, VT to White Mountains, NH. Explore Scenic Beauty: Falls, Foliage, and Mountains

Driving Distance: 256 KM

Explore the history of the Old Man of the Mountain at Franconia Notch State Park, where you will stroll to Profile Lake and enjoy panoramic views. Continue to The Basin, where a gentle walk along the Pemigewasset River brings you close to nature. Then, take in the vibrant fall foliage along the famous Kancamagus Highway, stopping at spots like Sabbaday Falls and Echo Lake. Wrap up your day in North Conway, exploring charming shops and savoring local New England flavors for dinner.
