Highlights

British Columbia's premier Indigenous destination resort, Klahoose offers an intimate coastal experience, that will leave you transformed by the beauty of the Klahoose territory, their Nation's unique culture, and the region's exceptional wildlife.

Situated in the heart of Desolation Sound, Klahoose Wilderness Resort is located on Homfray Channel between the Coast Mountain peaks of British Columbia's Sunshine Coast and the Northern Islands of the Salish Sea. All visitors meet at the lodge's patio, where they are greeted in the customary Klahoose manner. Stress immediately vanishes as osprey call across the Sound, the vision of an orca's particular dorsal fin breaks the water's surface, and the sea breeze drifts through the encompassing conifer woodland.

About Desolation Sound and Toba Inlet

Desolation Sound name was given by Captain George Vancouver, but the Coast Salish individuals have lived here since ancient times. Villages sites through the sound have been occasional homes for hundreds and even thoughts of First Nation individuals. Today Desolation Sound is famous for its characteristic excellence, rich wildlife is woven into the fabric of the individuals that have lived here for thousands of years before the European contact. Desolation Sound Marine Provincial Park has been known by boater as probably the calmest and hottest waters on the Pacific Coast.

Since time before memory, the Toba Inlet has been the home of the Klahoose individuals. This is one



of the main inlets on the BC coast. Toba Inlet is generally short when compared with other major coastal inlets with a normal width of 2.5 km and length just around 35 km. At the mouth of the bays is the Toba River and Klite River. The bay is flanked by tower iceberg peaks with waterfalls and is home to numerous grizzly bears.

- Great Room can also be transformed for activities such as fireside yoga, meeting room, presentation area.

- All-inclusive meal plan eat well and healthy. Vegetarian cuisine also offered.

Accommodations

Klahoose Wilderness Resort offers two different types of accommodation in a total of seven Lodge rooms and private Cabins.

Lodge Rooms

The main lodge has four Lodge Rooms available with two of these rooms featuring a private balcony overlooking Homfray Channel. These rooms sleep two to four guests and feature a queen or double bed and a private washroom. One Lodge Room is available with a double a separate room with bunks suitable for up to two small children.

Cabins

Located just steps away from the main lodge, the private cabins feature a large sitting area, balcony and one or two bedrooms. Each cabin has one private washroom. The cabins all feature stunning ocean views of Homfray Channel.

- Two 2-Bedroom Cabins come with a double bed in each of the bedrooms and two double beds in the open loft. Can sleep up to 6 persons.
- Three 1-Bedroom Cabin each come with one queen bed in the main bedroom and 2 double beds in the open loft. Can sleep up to 4 persons per cabin.

Resort Occupancy

Based on double occupancy Klahoose Wilderness Resort can accommodate 14 guests or 15-26 guests when sharing all the beds.

Resort Buyout

Klahoose Wilderness Resort is available for Resort Buy Out in which case highly customized services and meals can be offered.
